

22 Anti-Abortion Bills Currently Pending In the Illinois General Assembly (2021 Session)

IL HB261 – ULTRASOUND OPPORTUNITY ACT

Summary: Harassment of women, substituting medical judgement of doctors for anti-choice propaganda

IL HB338 – STATUTES BORN ALIVE INFANT

IL HB697 – INC TX PREGNANCY RESOURCE

Summary: Allows anti-choice activists to use state income tax dollars to support anti-choice propaganda and lie to pregnant women about pregnancy and abortion

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Creates an income tax credit in an amount equal to 50% of the contributions made by the taxpayer during the taxable year to one or more qualifying "pregnancy resource centers."

IL HB783 – ABORTION VARIOUS

Summary: Repeals HB 40

Amends the State Employees Group Insurance Act of 1971, the Illinois Public Aid Code, and the Problem Pregnancy Health Services and Care Act.

IL HB791 – REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH 20WKS

Summary: Repeals the Reproductive Health Act (RHA), bans abortion, imposes criminal penalties for doctors, eliminates life/health consequences for pregnant women

Amends the Reproductive Health Act. Makes conforming changes.

IL HB827 – PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTION BAN

Summary: "Partial Birth Abortion" doesn't exist in any medical literature, meant to demonize women and doctors with propaganda

Creates the Partial Birth Abortion Ban Act of 2021.

IL HB1717 – RIGHT OF CONSCIENCE ACT

Summary: Allows for any refusal for any reason to provide medical care while dismissing the health and welfare of any patient

Creates the Right of Conscience Act. Defines terms. Provides that no person or qualifying entity shall be coerced to act or engage in speech or held liable for refusing to engage in speech or refusing to act if such refusal was to exercise a right of conscience.

Amends the State Finance Act. Creates the Choose Life Fund as a special fund in the State treasury.

IL HB3041 – DHS AUDIT TAX FUNDED ABORTIONS

Summary: Requires state agencies to provide information so anti-choice extremists can harass and violate the privacy of patients, doctors, medical facilities and nonprofit organizations which provide medical information and care

Amends the Department of Human Services Act. Requires the Auditor General to conduct a post audit of all accounts and transactions of the Department of Human Services to determine the total amount in public funds the Department has expended since January 1, 2018 (effective date of HB 40) to cover costs of elective abortions and related services.

Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Requires the Department of Public Health to create and maintain a list of each immunizing agent derived from aborted fetal tissue and any alternative immunizing agents.

IL SB1856 – DIGNITY FOR ABORTED CHILDREN

Summary: *Harassment of doctors and women to increase the cost of an abortion in violation of the right to privacy*

Provides that it is unlawful for any physician, after performing an abortion in Illinois in which the patient elects to release the human fetal tissue to the physician, to fail to provide for the final disposition of the human fetal tissue through interment or cremation, consistent with State law regarding the disposal of human remains, not later than 7 days after the date on which the abortion procedure was performed. Contains provisions specifying civil penalties, criminal designations, and consideration of action by the Medical Disciplinary Board.
